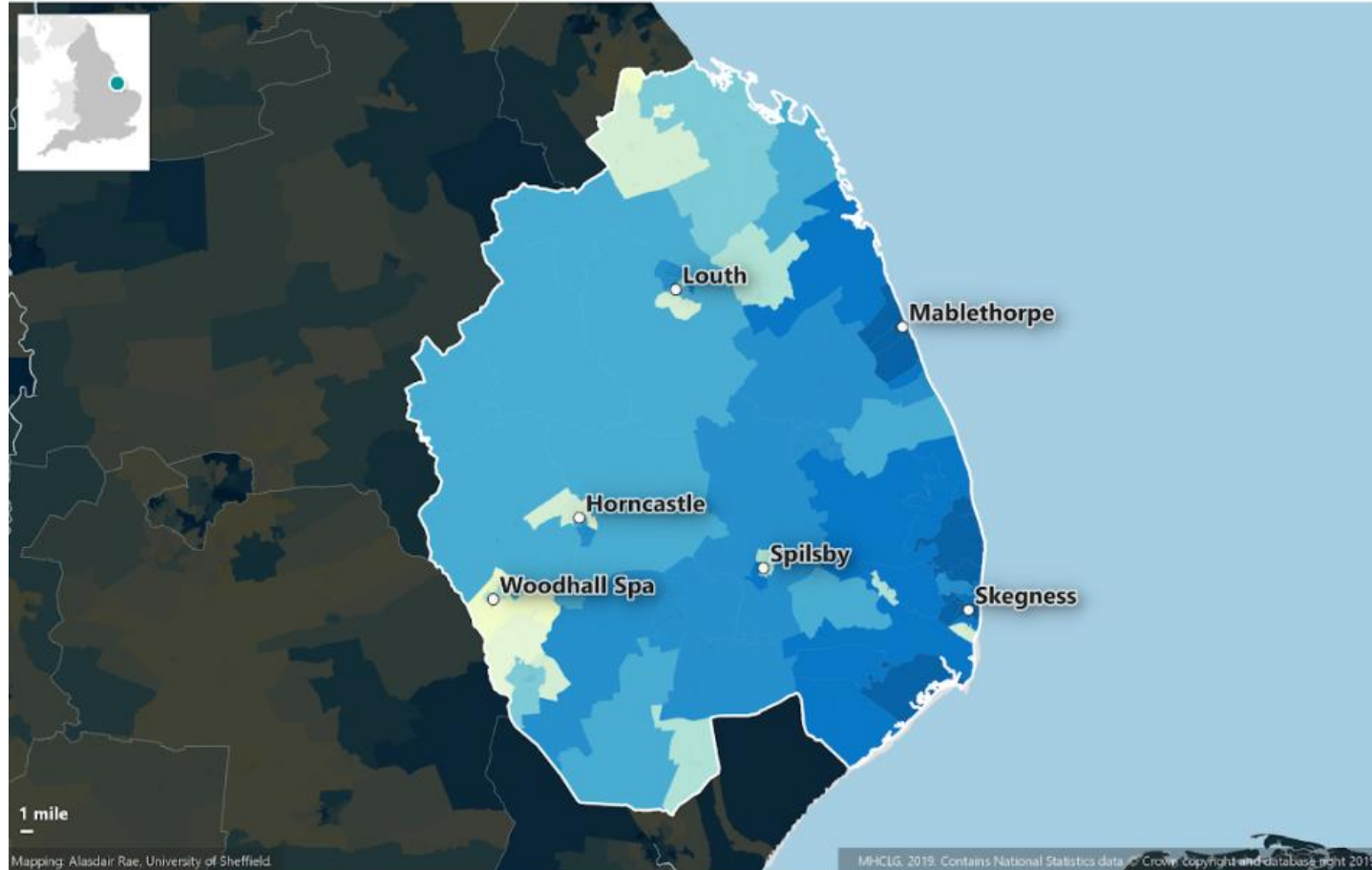

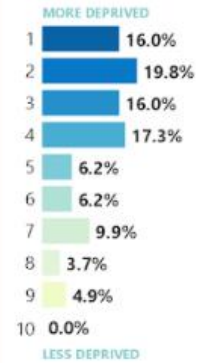

% of LSOAs in each national deprivation decile



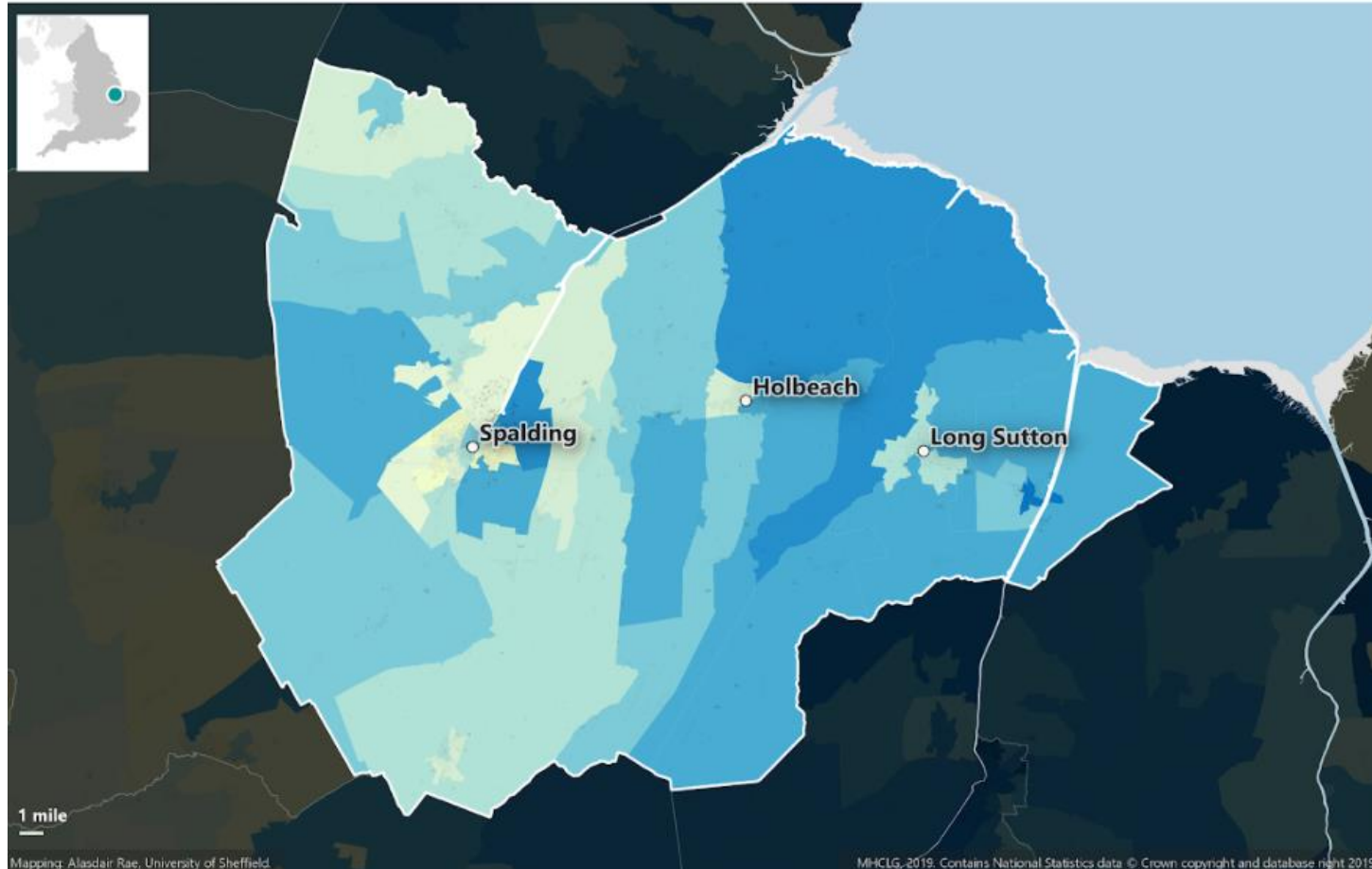

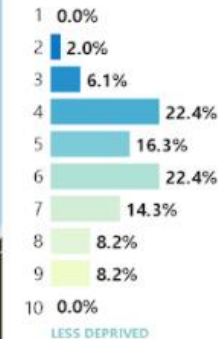

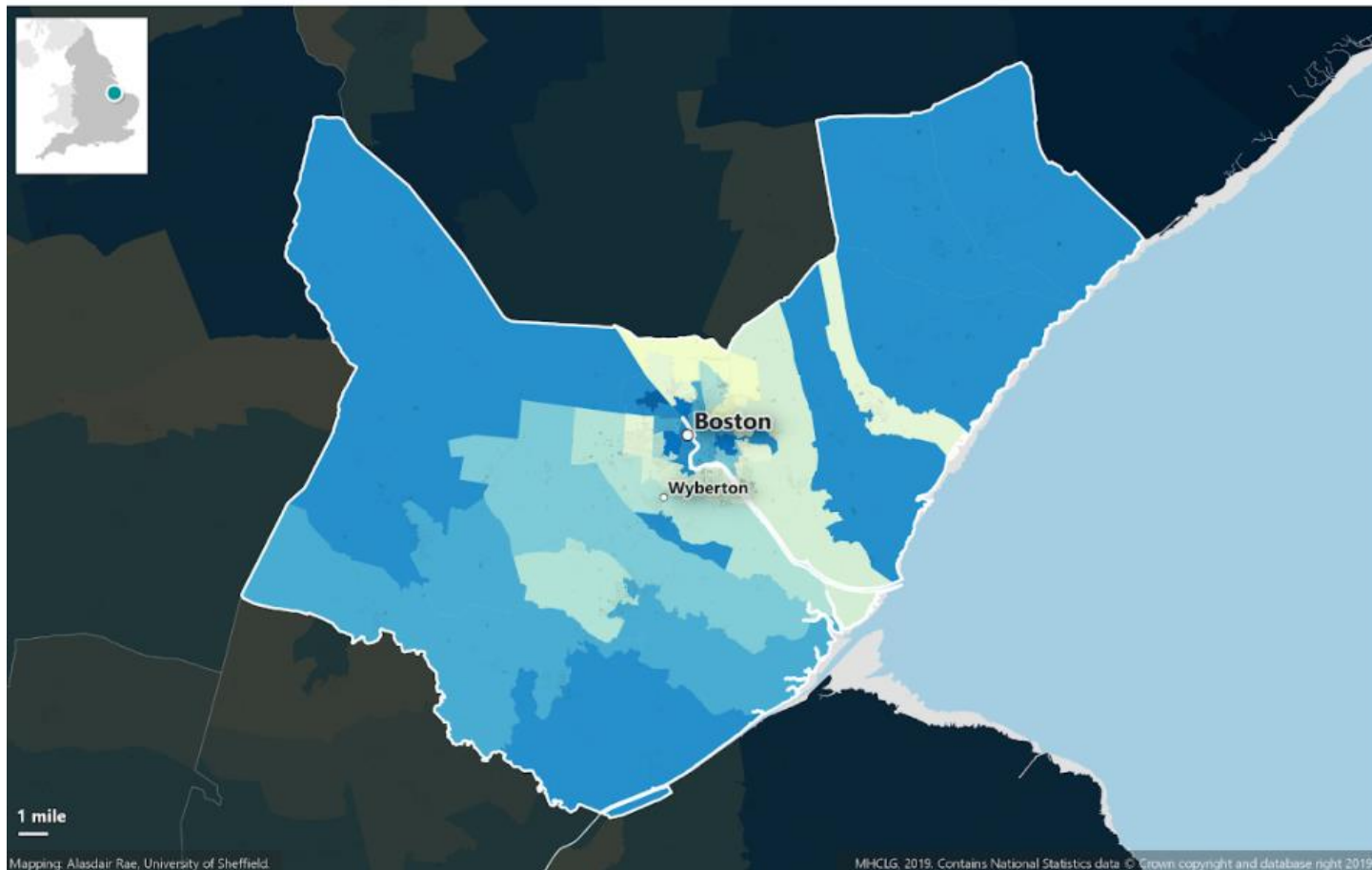

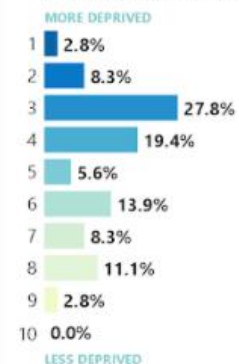

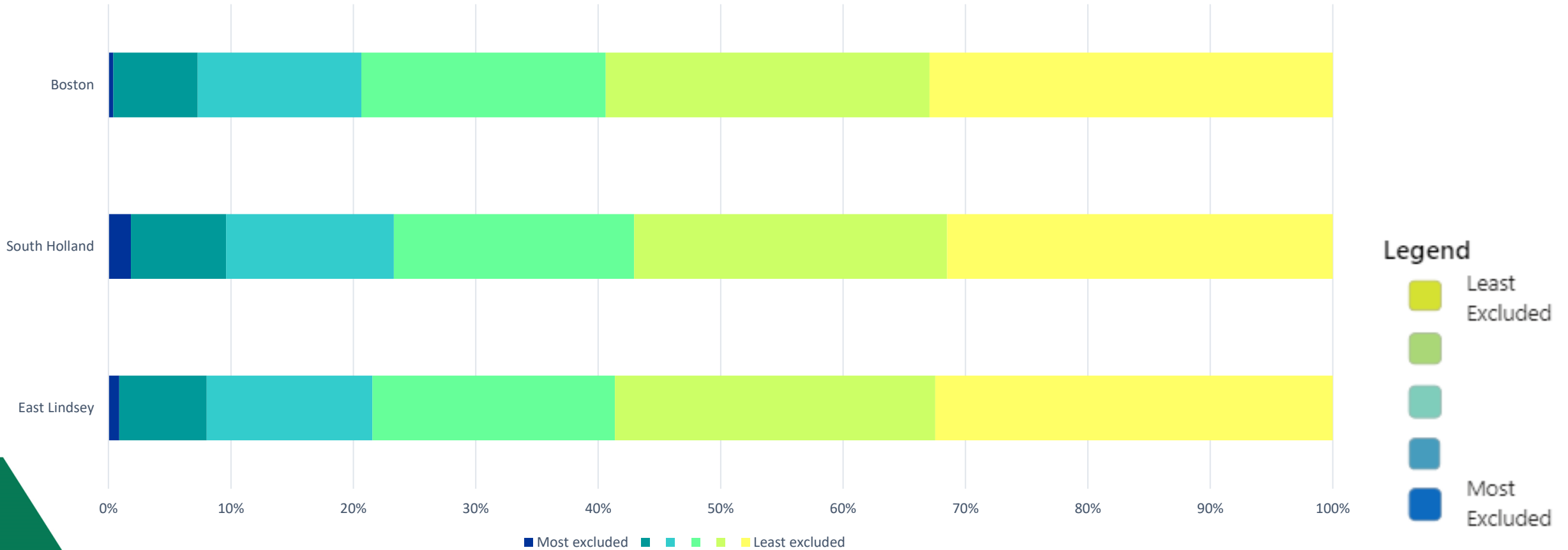
Digital Exclusion

Lincolnshire Digital Health Toolkit ranking digital exclusion

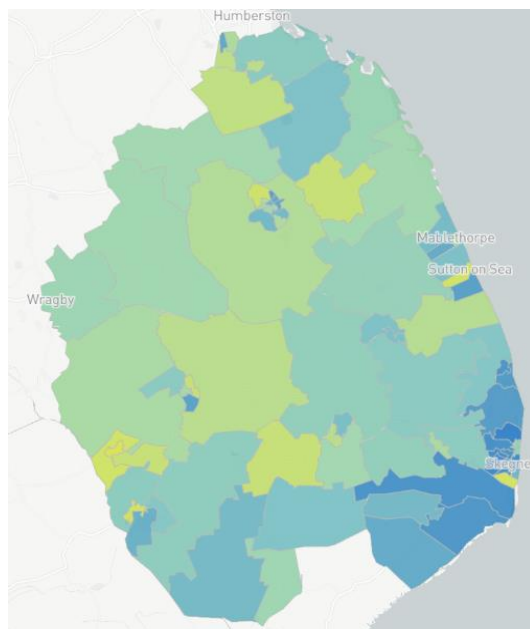

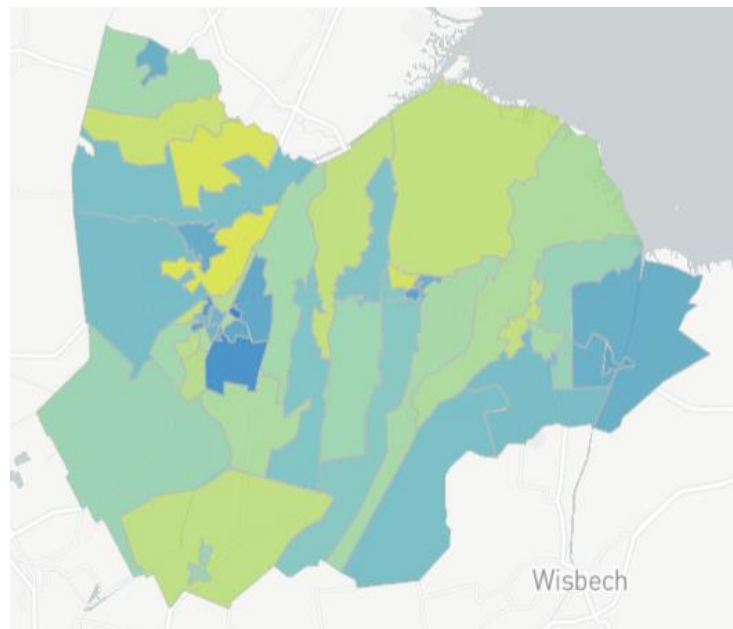


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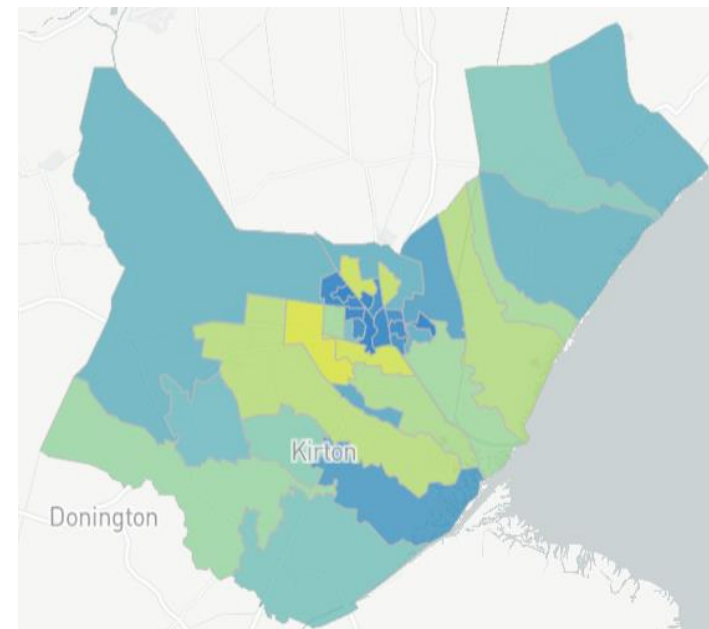
